



## THE HOWARD SCHOOL

### Uniform Policy

Students of The Howard School are to be nicely dressed and well groomed. We have found that the child's appearance helps to shape his/her attitude toward school; that it is serious and worthy of respect.

Please follow these uniform guidelines for your child's dress.

#### All Students:

- The child is to wear a school uniform unless the school has given specific instructions for the child to wear something else.
- All uniforms are to be neat, clean and in good repair.
- Sweatshirts or sweaters with school logos may be worn over uniform shirts.
- Sweatshirts or sweaters without the school logo may not be worn during school hours.
- Heavy coats and rain gear may be worn to school, but they may not be worn in the classrooms or at morning assembly. They may be worn at recess only with the teacher's permission.
- Heavy coats and rain gear may not have any commercial logos, numbers or pictures that are over two inches in diameter.
- Children who are involved in organizations such as Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts or 4-H may wear their uniforms to school on meeting days.
- Students should wear shoes that enable them to participate in a full range of school activities including outside play and P.E.
- Children may wear sandals with back straps only.
- Jewelry and accessories should be tasteful and moderate.
- Hats may be worn to school, but may not be worn during school hours.

#### Boy's Required Dress:

- Shirt must be a school polo, turtleneck or button-down oxford shirt.
  
- Polo and turtleneck shirts must be a solid color embroidered with the school logo:
- Button-down oxfords do not have to have the school logo, and are allowable in the following colors only:
  - ✓ White

- ✓ Light blue
- ✓ Light yellow
- Shirts are to be tucked in.
- Boys may wear pants or dress shorts.
- Pants or shorts may not be baggy; they must be worn at the waist.
- Pants or shorts with pockets on the side (including but not limited to cargo pants) may not be worn.
- Pants with zippers that convert them to shorts may not be worn
- If pants or shorts have belt loops, a belt must be worn.
- Pants or shorts are allowable in the following colors only:
  - ✓ Navy blue
  - ✓ Tan
  - ✓ Black
- Boys may wear shorts in the school plaid:
  - ❖ Lands' End: Hunter/Classic Navy
  - ❖ French Toast: Green

#### **Girl's Required Dress:**

- Top must be a school polo, turtleneck, peter pan, or oxford button-down shirt or blouse.
- Polo and turtleneck shirts must be a solid color embroidered with the school logo:
- Button-down oxford or peter pan blouses do not have to have the school logo, and are allowable in the following colors only:
  - ✓ White
  - ✓ Light blue
  - ✓ Light yellow
- Girls may wear pants, dress shorts, skorts, skirts, or jumpers in the following colors only:
  - ✓ Navy blue
  - ✓ Tan
  - ✓ Black
  - ✓ School plaid
    - ❖ Lands' End: Hunter/Classic Navy
    - ❖ French Toast: Green
- Skirts or jumpers must be knee length.
  - ✓ Leggings, tights, or long socks may only be worn with skirts, skorts, or jumpers.
  - ✓ Leggings, tights, or long socks must be a solid color that is color coordinated to the skirt, skorts, or jumper.
- Pants or shorts may not be baggy; they must be worn at the waist.
- Pants or shorts with pockets on the side (including but not limited to cargo pants) may not be worn.
- Pants with zippers that convert them to shorts may not be worn.

- **If pants or shorts have belt loops, a belt is to be worn.**

**Notes:**

- ❖ **Children who come to school without the uniform will be required to change before they go to class. The school will provide the child with the necessary uniform articles, and an invoice for the articles will be sent to the parents. The invoice will reflect the cost of the clothing plus shipping and handling charges.**
- ❖ **Repeated violation of the uniform policy will be grounds for disciplinary action. Such actions may include but are not limited to suspension or dismissal. Parents of children who are dismissed for this reason are responsible for the balance of the annual tuition at the time of dismissal.**
